Key Responsibilities:

- Perform routine landscaping and grounds maintenance, including mowing, trimming, and edging
- Maintain park cleanliness by collecting litter and servicing waste receptacles

- Inspect park facilities and report maintenance or safety issues
- Support setup and breakdown for park events as needed

- Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions
