Prospective bidders must provide name, mailing address, email, and telephone number to receive documents. Addenda will be issued only to registered document holders, and bids will be accepted only from those on record as having obtained bid documents.

All bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes clearly marked: **“SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE (LIQUID CHLORINE)”**, and addressed to the Village Clerk, Village of Monroe, 7 Stage Road, Monroe, NY 10950.
